Seed Exchange Order Processing

Benedikt will wait several weeks until he has a significant number of seed orders before sending out any seeds. He will then attempt to satisfy demand such that everyone gets at least some seed.

Seed Donors will still have their orders satisfied first.

Seeds to the USA

For several years the Society has been able to send seeds to our USA members. The process is slightly contorted in that all seed must go via a recognised and registered importer. Dan Long has volunteered to continue to perform this task, which has been successful in previous years.

Members in the USA should fill in their requests and send them to Benedikt as noted above. Benedikt will wait for a few weeks so that he can package all seeds for the USA in a single parcel, which he will send to US Customs for inspection. Assuming the seeds are OK, US Customs will send them on to Dan Long. Dan, who will have a list of who requested what, will then forward the individual seed packets to the requesting members.

Obviously, this process will delay receipt of seeds by a few weeks, so please be patient.
